As a public utility, Mora Municipal Utilities is governed by a three member utilities commission and is responsible for operating water, wastewater and electric utilities within the City of Mora.

Decisions about the operation and rates of Mora Municipal Utilities are made locally, by members of the community, at open and transparent public meetings. Because all decisions are made locally, the utility is able to keep costs low compared to other area electric service providers.

And whether a customer has a compliment or complaint, he or she can discuss the issue locally and be assured that their voice will be heard.
